

Stealing info or pictures

Facebook

There is a post that is being shared on Facebook. It makes people think their information or pictures is safe from being stolen. However, that is false.

If the information can be seen on Facebook (or any other online forum), it can be stolen. Once it is stolen, it is hard to prove the individual that has the information is the one that actually stole the information. Even if you have all your information locked to where you can't download the information, pictures, comments, or anything else, they can still steal it.

There are posts that is going around Facebook that are being circulated for various reasons (not the user that shares the post but the originator of the post).

There are various reasons for the post. One is that posting the information, doesn't protect you, it doesn't protect your information, pictures, or files.

There are several possible reasons why these posts are being posted (not by the one posting it but the originator of the original post)

- 1. The post is to flood Facebook
- 2. After a post is shared numerous times, the originator of the post swaps out post for a picture of a product and sells it to the manufacturer of the product. The manufacturer can use it to entice viewers with the number of views it has.

Below is an example of many posts being circulated that is false!!!

"Don't forget tomorrow starts the new Facebook (aka...new name, META) rule where they can use your photos. Don't forget the Deadline is today!!!

If you prefer, you can copy and paste this version. If you do not publish a statement at least once it will be tacitly allowing the use of your photos, as well as the information contained in the profile status updates.

DO NOT SHARE. Copy and paste.

Their new algorithm chooses the same few people - about 25 - who will read your posts.

Therefore:

Hold your finger down anywhere in this post and "copy" will pop up. Click "copy". Then go to your page, start a new post and put your finger anywhere in the blank field. "Paste" will pop up and click paste

This will bypass the system.
