
Senior running back Darryl Sadler carried the load rushing for 1360 yards this year. Sadler was named to the all-city team and received a scholarship to Western Kentucky.

In National Forensic Contest



Madison High School won the National Student Congress Trophy at the National Forensic League National Speech Tournament held June, 1981, at the University of Utah in Salt Lake City. They also placed first for the Student Congress Sweepstakes Trophy.

Participants from Madison were Mark Merryman, who participated in the House of Representatives, and Jason Tanner, a member for the Senate.

Merryman, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Merryman, was named an "Outstanding Representative" and placed second in the nation.

Tanner, son of Mr. and Mrs. John D. Tanner, was named an "Outstanding Senator." Madison was the only school to have two honored congressmen. The Harvard School of Los Angeles finished second and Bellarmine Preparatory School, Sacramento, placed third.

Merryman and Tanner tied for "Best Debator in Tennessee" at the Tennessee Speech and Drama League state finals at Tennessee Tech in April. They also finished third in debate at the National Forensic League State Tournament. Both are 1981 honor graduates of Madison, and entered the University of Tennessee at Knoxville in September of 81.

Madison sent its first congressman to the national tournament in 1963 at Rice University, Houston, TX. Tyree B. Harris, IV, was elected president of the Senate and was the only Tennessean honored at the tournament.

Steven G. Doochin — President of the Senate in 1968.


